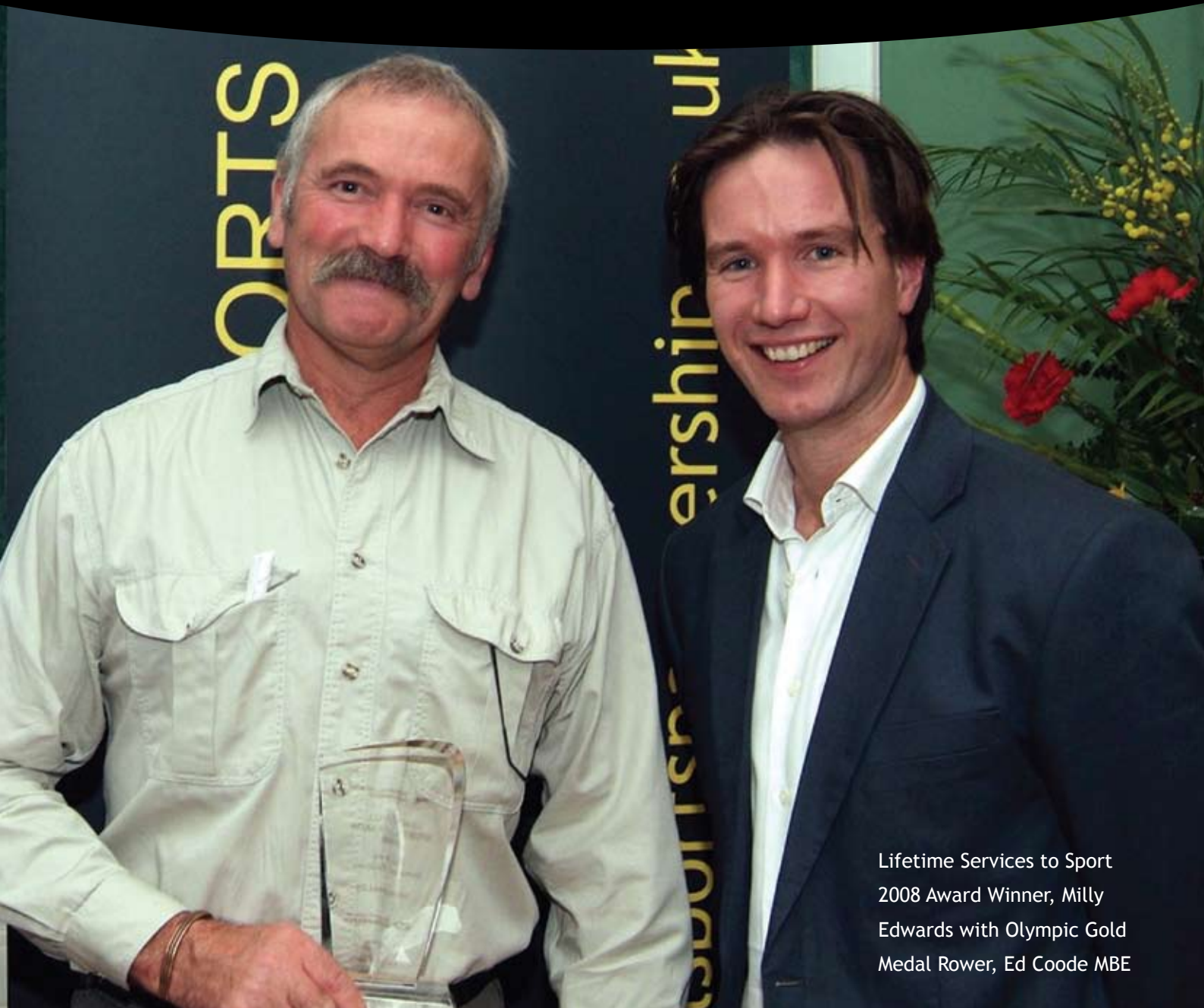

## Coaching category

### 1. Male Coach of the Year

### 2. Female Coach of the Year

### 5. Club of the Year – adult

The winner of this award will have excelled in the delivery of an overall sporting experience within a club environment. The club will have evidence of social and community development, together with a commitment to club and volunteer development.

### 6. Club of the Year - junior

The winner of this award will have excelled in the delivery of an overall sporting experience within a club environment. The club will have created links with schools and be open to the whole community. The club will also be committed to club and volunteer development.



### 3. Young Coach of the Year – U25

The winner of this award will display dedication, passion and enthusiasm to coaching. This coach will have made a contribution and commitment to players/athletes, together with demonstrating personal maturity.

### 4. Official of the Year

The winner of this award will have demonstrated a commitment as an official, umpire or referee together with commitment to their own personal development. There will be evidence of development, achievement and leading by example.

### 7. Club of the Year – 2009 The winner of this award will come from one of the nominations in the above awards

The winner of this award will have excelled in the delivery of an overall sporting experience within a club environment. The club will have evidence of a commitment to all age groups, together with coach, club and volunteer development.

### 8. Best Club to Volunteer for

The winner of this award will be recognised for providing a welcoming club that values its volunteers. The winning club will have a focus on volunteer recruitment, retention and reward making it the best club to volunteer at in Cornwall.
